Non-potable water is supplied by the local river system and/or ditch systems to deliver water. THMD or the Ditch Company does not know when the river water comes in and/or when there is enough water to fill our non-potable water storage pond. Non-potable water will be normally turned on the first week of May for testing. Non-potable will be available per the watering schedule the second Tuesday of May, depending on water availability.

Non-potable water system can be turned off on rain days with an accumulation of ½ inch of rain over a 24 hour period. Non-potable water can be off for up to 48 hours. Non-potable water is non-treated lake & river water it may have dis-color and/or an odor.

Do not go into the District meter pit.

If your non-potable water is not working during the scheduled watering time, please check the following:

Your main water valve after the District meter pit is on.

1. Your main water valve after the District meter pit is on.
2. Rain sensor is not full of water.
3. You have your irrigation clock turned on & set to water at the same time as the watering schedule for your area.
4. Check your irrigation clock for the correct time, am and pm, and have set the correct year.
5. Check back up battery supply.
6. Check and clean in-line filter.
7. Flow issues with irrigation heads, clean heads and filters. Heads should be cleaned often.
